Respecting ancient traditions, working in harmony with the land, or showcasing an innovative spirit, these are the values that make our selected domaines stand out.

From family-owned domaines passed down through generations of winegrowers, to organic and innovative redevelopments, **NewRhône Millésimes** wishes to highlight all of them and their diversity.

Domaine de Cabane

Côtes-du-Rhône 2017

The vines of the Estate, located on the heights of St Martin d'Ardèche on a clay-limestone plateau covered with rolled pebbles, is planted with old vines over 40 years old.

Domaine Mathiflo

Beaumes de Venise 2017

Domaine Mathiflo was created in 2012 when two families joined forces. From then on, each generation has developed its own legacy of productive vineyards situated in the heights of the appellation, at the foot of the village of Suzette, on an exceptional terroir (Triassic, clay-limestone, white earth, grey marl).



Château Chante Mistral

Lirac 2017

Family estate for four generations, Château Chante Mistral covers 30 hectares of vines in Saint-Geniès-de-Comolas. Its vines of the Lirac appellation blossom on rolled pebble hillsides, where sand and clay blend.



Domaine de l'Eyrolle

Lirac 2017

With its 30-year-old vines, Domaine de l'Eyrolle, covers the three terroirs of Lirac: the high alluvial terraces of the Rhône, the limestone hillsides and the plain of grey sand. These multiple terroirs give each grape variety its character, typical of the appellation.

Château de Bouchassy

Lirac 2017

Château de Bouchassy covers 28 hectares, over a terroir dating from 1628. Named after the first Consul of the town of Roquemaure, the estate has been owned since the 1970s by the Degoul family, who, for four generations, has combined its desire to innovate with fundamental values: tradition, authenticity and quality..

Domaine Gisele, D. & R. Vernay

Côte Rôtie

Situated at the extreme north of the appellation, at Saint Cyr-sur-Rhône, the vineyards of this estate cover hillsides, ranging from 200 to 350 metres altitude with old vines and harvesting by hand as their signature.



Organics domaines

Domaine de la Grand' Ribe

Côtes du Rhône rouge 2016 - Côtes du Rhône blanc 2016 – Côtes du Rhône Villages 2015 – Côtes du Rhône Villages Ste Cécile les Vignes 2016

"Domaine de la Grand 'Ribe" ("ribe" meaning "frontier" in Provençal language) straddles the Drôme and Vaucluse areas. Founded in 1940, this family-owned estate which has been certified organic since 2002, and NOP since 2007 cares equally about protecting its terroir and producing wines naturally: harvesting by hand, vinification and ageing in an underground cellar or in oak casks all demonstrate its commitment to quality.



Clos des Mûres

Côtes-du-Rhône 2017 – CDR Villages Visan 2017

FR-BIO-01 - sans sulfites ajoutés

From an estate which has been family-owned since 1922, located in Visan, a Drôme Provençale village in l'enclave des Papes. Its 30 hectares of vines are surrounded by lavender fields destined for essential oils production, and mulberry trees, once used for silkworms rearing, hence the name of the estate.





Châteauneuf-du-Pape

Elaborated and vinified by Domaine de Courten

ROMAIN DUVERNAY Châteauneuf du Pape Organic is vinified and grown on the property of Domaine de Courten. Christophe DE COURTEN, vinegrower in organic farming, operates six hectares of ancestral lands on the appellation, out of which certain vines are centenarians.

Domaine du Val des Rois

Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Valréas 2018

Emmanuel Bouchard who is from the 9th generation of a family of winegrowers, has been running Domaine du Val des Rois since 1997. He originally trained as a biologist and combines tradition and modernity to produce very fine wines showcasing the most beautiful expression of terroir and the quality of its grape varieties. Awarded organic certification by Ecocert, the whole estate is free from synthetic products and its soil is enriched only by organic matter, thanks to a plant compost.



Clos Volabis

Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Suze-La-Rousse 2018

Situated on the Visan and Tulette hills, Clos Volabis is a family-owned estate spread over 60 hectares, therefore creating an ecosystem with an exceptional biodiversity. In order to develop its biodiversity, vines grow alongside olive trees and lavender as well as truffle oaks and grain fields. Certified organic for 10 years already, the exposure of its vineyards together with its diversity of grape varieties and age of its vines produce fine, aromatic wines which are a perfect expression of terroir.
